Call to Order - Gaume

Treasurer's Report – Harewood

Membership Report – Jacobi

1128 members – our goal was 1200. If we get to 1135 we'll be lucky! Novice payments begin the 10-11 membership year. The tri-regional meeting in May will also be for the 10-11 membership year.

Conference 2011 – Gaume

Don Taylor, who is acting on NYSFAAA's behalf for the 2010 and 2011 conferences, has informed Curt that the Turning Stone is not willing to renegotiate our contract. Specifically, they do not want to drop the room block down from 425 to 275 on peak nights and they do not want to drop a day off from the total of four. Don Taylor informed Curt that we would have approximately a \$10,000 obligation to be completely released from the contract. Don Taylor thinks they may be willing to give us an amended contract. Don Taylor's recommendation to me and for the Council's consideration is to basically call their bluff. He is willing to draft a letter from me (with our input) essentially saying that unless we receive an amended contract, NYSFAAA is willing to write a check and not bring the NYSFAAA 2011 conference to the Turning Stone. His argument is that he

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does not fell that the Turning Stone is willing to sacrifice the revenue that would realize even with amended contract against a \$10,000 (approximately) buyout. He is also referring to a section in the contract entitled Force Majeure (3rd page) which allows us to use to dissolve the contract.

Discussion took place. We need clarification on where the \$10,000 figure comes from, but we also need to realize that the loss that will incur if we don't meet the 475 room block.

In conference 2009 we had about 300-350 attendees. We used about 210-230 rooms.

Evaluation of the Website & Social Networking by Ian Leslie

No Geo Tags or META tags – to associate our site with New York.

It is content heavy – difficult to find content if you don't know where to find it. Can we do a traffic analysis to find out where people are going?

Who are we aiming to serve on the website?

Conference 2011 - Gaume

Today's conference call took place to discuss the revised Turning Stone contract. The revised contract has a reduced room block (from 1350 total rooms down to 610 total rooms) and reduced the length of the conference by one day to coincide with the shorter schedule (depart on Thursday 10/20/11 rather than Friday 10/21/11).

A discussion took place regarding the uncertainty of the future and whether NYSFAAA members will have travel budgets. Per the new contract the 610 rooms @ \$115 = \$750,000 in revenue and \$23,515 in food & beverage revenue for the Turning Stone. We need to use 80% of the room block which is 488 rooms. In Saratoga, we used 458 rooms.

Additional conversation took place regarding our concerns about the audio visual rental requirement (A/V rental is usually very expensive if we don't have the opportunity to shop around for our own vendor and/or bring in our own laptops and projectors). There are specific rules about alcohol at the Turning Stone, and clarification is needed on that topic, too.

A group of NYSFAAA members will plan a visit to the Turning Stone (Mark, Jan, Curt, Dan, Ann, and others if needed).

April 17th is the date that we would need to break the contract and pay a fine.

<u>A MOTION</u> was made by Maria DeInnocentiis: "To give Curt the authorization to sign the revised Turning Stone contract on behalf of NYSFAA."

Second: Clair Jacobi No one opposed. Rick Cole –abstain. Motion passed.

Curt will wait to sign it until the group meets with Turning Stone representatives.

Governance Issues – Tramuta

A conference call is scheduled on Monday at 3:00 to discuss the bylaws to change our treasury to a centralized system.
