THE SCHOLARSHIP PROCESS:

- 3. Print the attached Student Scholarship Application or download the Student Scholarship Application from the NYSFAAA website (*Member Center Misc Online Forms*).
- 4. Have the student complete their portion of the application.
- 5. A financial aid administrator completes the school section of the application.
- 6. The application must be sent to the Committee Co-Chairs no later than <u>October 1, 2019</u>. You determine the date the applications are due in your office. That date should be early enough to give you time to review the applications and complete the Administrator's section.

When students sign the application, they are giving their Financial Aid Office permission to release their academic and financial aid information to the Scholarship Committee. They are also giving the committee chairs permission to access NSLDS to obtain information about the applicant's federal loan indebtedness. Finally, the student certification will allow the publication of the names of the students who are selected for this award.
